DIMENSIONS:

- Ensure that the Program offices have complete plans developed that meet the program quality standards.
- Support the Regional Coordinator in coordinating and managing the program development processes at sub-regional and regional levels.
- Ensure that plan documents are live and visible documents for program staff and partner accountability to beneficiaries.

2. MONITORING, EVALUATION AND LEARNING

- Facilitate and coordinate the development of a Monitoring System for the entire program in the various sub-regions.
- Develop and manage a plan for Program Monitoring Reviews, Country Learning Reviews and coordinate its implementation.
- Capture learning and innovative experiences within countries and sub-regions and communicate this learning across programs, and within the region.
- Support partner monitoring processes by controlling to qualitative and quantitative reporting standards
